Itinerary

Day 1: Wed 30th Jan 2013 - Siem Reap arrival - Boat cruise floating village

Arrival and take relax in the hotel.

In the evening at **16h15** transfer to the lake for sunset boat cruise at Tonle Sap Lake:

Located about 25 minutes away from Siem Reap city, the Tonle Sap Lake is one of the non-temple related places of interest nearby Siem Reap city.

The lake is the biggest fresh water lake in southeast Asia by size. However its size changes significantly throughout the year, during the wet season it measures more than 10,000 sq. kilometers, while during the dry season it shrinks to about 3,000 sq. kilometers.



You will board a boat and visit the Chong Kneas Village where you will pass by floating houses, restaurants (Khmer and Korean dishes), churches, markets, a billiard house, schools, souvenir shops, a floating police station, a floating crocodile farm, or even “floating” dogs and pigs !

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Day 2: Thu 31stJan 2013 - Angkor Thom - Ta Prom - Angkor Wat

At **8h30** depart from the hotel to visit the Great City of **Angkor Thom**, which was the last capital of the Great Khmer Empire under the reign of Jayavarman VII.

This city is surrounded by a 8 m high wall, each side of the city is 4 km long.

It draws a perfect square you access this town through 5 gates; 4 of them represent the cardinal points and the 5th one the Victory Gate was the one leading directly to the Royal Palace Area.

You will arrive via the South Gate, an impressive stone gate carved with Elephants and 4 giant faces.

Continue explore to the small circuit:



The most famous among these is **Ta Prohm** temple, built in the mid 12th to early 13th centuries.

Ta Prohm is unique in that it has been left largely as it was found: Overgrown by jungle trees and vines, with many parts of the temple crumbling to the ground.

This makes Ta Prohm one of the most picturesque and memorable of Angkor temples.

Back hotel in during the lunch time and relax.

In the afternoon at around **15h00** go back again to visit the most famous and magnificent **Angkor Wat temple**.

Its original state, the most famous and magnificent **Angkor Wat Temple** (early-mid 12th century) dedicated to the Hindu god Vishnu.

This huge temple-mountain, built by King Suryavarman II is considered as the masterpiece of Khmer architecture and art.
